The plan is it will revert back to being a weekly competition provided sufficient helpers can be found. If you are willing and able to help please let Bob know. He will be needing people to help with starting, results at the end of the evening and handicapping.

Men's Club Captain report

The last month has been a challenge with very large fields due to other club closures and issues with dot golf systems, teaming up partners on the computer after a 4-ball stableford and the sloppiness with which a lot of score cards were incomplete or wrongly entered. So I would like to especially thank those on starting, the cards and match committee members who gave me their assistance.

Last week with mandatory card completion and scanning saw the results achieved much easier, even with the large field. However, I think we will need to continue paying attention to the consistency of our score keeping. I propose that we can go back to input at the kiosks as an option but must have the cards returned to the main desk so that they are there for verification rather than being binned.

Slow play has and always will be an issue as some players refuse to adopt ready golf and tend to meander along like Mr Browns Cows. This in effect further delays the results, with one group recorded at 45 minutes behind the second last group. We need to be considerate of other players in the field.

I have talked to visiting golfers who have all been very complimentary as to how well our course is playing, so well done to all concerned.

I attended a meeting of Central Otago Golf. As usual there was a lot of discussion on the way our pennants was being played and the issue of timing. There was also a suggestion we may need to look at changing the banding of the various grades in light of the effect of handicapping changes. Also discussed was the funding of Junior golf to go to tournaments which will always be an issue. At issue also was the Central Otago Golf Champs that continue to struggle for entries. This again seemed to be a matter of timing with clubs but I also suspect that it is not widely advertised or pushed. Little was resolved on all issues.

The "Old Smuggler" has reached a final to be played on the 31st July. What is rare is that we will have father vs son in the teams with Robin Pimm/Tony Clark playing Sam Pimm/Bernie Scoles.

The draw for the Goodalls Memorial is up and underway as well with good entry numbers.

Dean Murphy (NZ Golf) has indicated he has engaged Michael Goldstein of The Clubhouse Ltd to undertake a short piece of assessment work for the Cromwell Golf Club and he expects this to commence next week. This is being funded by Golf NZ.
