His practical mechanical skills are an asset to the club, and he has shown that he can turn his hand to building or repairing almost anything.

He has manufactured 10 bench seats, that are sited on various tee areas around the course. Perhaps the best visible example of Lester's handyman skills is the raffle wheel, used during virtually all our club days and tournaments.

Lester has dedicated a great deal of his life to the service of the Cromwell community at the same time as serving his golf club. Lester was a member of the Cromwell Volunteer Fire Brigade for most of his adult life. Lester has represented the NZ Fire Service in Australasian tournaments (between 1984 and 1992) and has competed in two World Fire Fighters Games, in Sheffield, England and Christchurch.

Lester's name is inscribed on our honour's boards, multiple times, as a Club Champion and winner of The Goodall Memorial and The Old Smuggler, also on many of the cups and trophies in the trophy cabinet spanning from the beginning of his membership, through to recent years.

In recognition of his long service to golf, Lester was inducted as a member of the Eagles Golfing Society in 2019.

There was much more in Doug's presentation but that hopefully gives some indication of the contribution Lester has made to the Club and Cromwell.
